Fleet Numerical Meteorology and Oceanography Center (FNMOC), its corporate affiliates, research and development partners, and prospective National Operational Weather Forecast Grid (NOWFoG) partners, cordially invite you to attend a conference focusing on "Planning and Implementing an Operational High Performance Computing Grid," August 10-12, 2004, at the Hilton Monterey, 1000 Aguajito Road, Monterey, CA.

Because of the positive early response to the conference proposal, we expanded the program to three days including a final day workshop on the IBM Grid Toolbox on the FNMOC campus. The conference will address challenges associated with the rapidly expanding interest in grid computing and its applicability to operational requirements.
